The Structure of the Astrakhan Branch of the Foreign Students Association in Russia is as follows:

The Astrakhan Branch of the Foreign Students Association in Russia was established at Astrakhan State University in 2012. It has united over 1, 400 foreign students who get education at Astrakhan's higher educational institutions.

Our tasks are as follows:

- 5. Contribution to mutual understanding and friendship between nations:
